Comments: Even though this story is part of the Lewis Carroll's Alice in Wonderland story, if you think it will be sweet and wonderful, maybe you better stop here. This is a new take on an old tale, it may frighten you, it may give you nightmares. Let me give you the run down. First off the artwork is very gothic like and fits well with the story perfectly. In fact the cover is pretty spooky to look at, I thought I was looking at Jack the Ripper, but I was actually looking at Hatter Madigan with his tall hat, evil stare and blade positioned out and ready to strike. Hatter Madigan is on an odyssey, he is searching for Alyss - Wonderland's lost princess. Alice in Wonderland told by Lewis Carroll you will learn was a big lie. In fact it was Alyss/Alice that told the tale to Lewis Carroll and Lewis made it into the fantasy story for children. The true story is much more darker. This is a mini-series that will take you down an unknown road into something that is mysterious and forbidden. Let me tell you what you will find in the first issue. You will get a kick out Hatter's hat. Remember the big fat Japanese guy in one of those James Bond movies, that was able to toss his derby black hat and it was used as a weapon?
